

Decades of monocropping and changing climate patterns have taken a toll, with groundwater levels dropping dramatically from 3-10 metres in the late '90s to over 30 metres today. Yet, Punjab is fighting back through bold reforms: promoting crop diversification, direct seeding of rice (DSR), solar irrigation, MSP-backed procurement of alternative crops, and targeted support for sustainable technologies. The upcoming Regional Policy Dialogue in Chandigarh will build on this momentum, bringing together experts, policymakers, and institutions to create a replicable blueprint, one that places at the centre of India's Puniab back agricultural transformation.
